



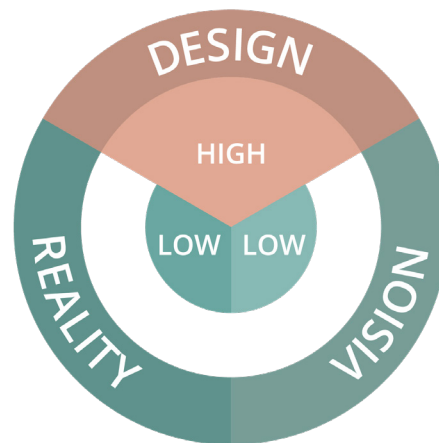
It looks like you've experienced a Crucible Moment, but you are not yet ready to approach it as an opportunity.
